

Template Instructions

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Downloading templates

1. On your hard drive create a folder for all of your website files.
2. To view the templates click on the template's link on http://www.csm.ornl.gov/Internships/rams_06/web_dev.html.
3. To retrieve the template click on View → View Source.
4. Copy the HTML code and past it into a new .html file in your html editor.

Downloading the images

You must download the images for each template to work.

1. Create a folder in your website folder named "images".
2. On the web development page (http://www.csm.ornl.gov/Internships/rams_06/web_dev.html) click on the "images" link under "Website Templates".
3. You can download these images by right clicking on each file name.

Working with templates

These templates were made to be adjusted by swapping out images, colors, and content. Some templates are more complex than others. If a template containing cascading style sheets is being used, the style sheets can be manipulated to change the text formatting. If a template, not containing style sheets, is being used, the tag can be applied to define font size, color, and face.

Saving and testing

1. Save your adjusted template file as index.html if it is your home page.
2. If the file is another page, give it a name that corresponds to the content of your page. If the page consists of your contact information you might want to name it contact.html.
3. To test your website open a browser, click on File → Open File.
