

What's in a Name?

You may be wondering, "Who is Poogan, anyway?" As legend has it, Poogan's Porch is named after a little dog.

Poogan's Porch was built as a spacious, commodious home in 1888. By 1976 the owners sold their home, and moved away. They left their faithful dog behind. His name was Poogan. He became the guardian of the house-now-restaurant. From his perch on the front porch, he greeted customers. Successive restaurant owners cherished

him. He became an institution.

Poogan died a natural death in 1979. We still miss him.


