


More details about my life.

I was married for three years. It began in 98 shortly after I finished my studies and started my professorship at the Univ. of Colorado in Colorado Springs (a beautiful place that I would like to take you sometime, horse back riding in the mountains [an experience I will never forget]). Let me explain *briefly* the story. From her home in Venezuela, we flew together to Aruba and stayed a week on the beach and I proposed, she accepted, it was all such a dream. The research I conducted there led me away from medicine into computer science and I liked it so much that I never looked back.
